Information regarding return of First Rush Data for KS4 and Post 16 Results for 2018 Data Collection Forms

You will be aware that we request the return of a fax or email to record the results from KS4 and Post 16. The proformas are at the end of this letter and I would be grateful for your support in completing and returning them.

The Post 16 and KS4 data is due on **16 and 23 August 2018** respectively – it is very important that the return is with the LA by **midday on these dates**.

The purpose of the collection of early data is to provide:

- a. an early view of how well students achieved across Wiltshire for internal sharing within WASSH and for the LA
- b. information for the LA to be able to produce a county wide view of performance in order to produce a Wiltshire press release for the media on results days

As last year, the LA analysis and reporting will relate to the data that will populate the performance tables and therefore we are asking you to return only your **first** set of results.

We have made changes to the KS4 proforma this year in keeping with the new accountability measures.

For KS4

We are collecting the following results:

- Attainment 8 average score
- Ebacc average APS score
- % EBacc pass at 4+ and 5+
- % Basics pass at 4+ and 5+
- % English pass 4+ and 5+
- % maths pass 4+ and 5+

For Post 16

The sheet enables you to record results for your students who have studied:

- a) A levels/Applied Levels
- b) Level 3 vocational subjects
- c) A mix of A levels and vocational subjects

This is the same as last year. Each student's results should be recorded in only one of the boxes.

With the focus on the progress of disadvantaged students being such high priority at both school and LA level, we will repeat the collection of first rush KS4 data for disadvantaged students (FSM, FSMEver6 or CLA). We do not want your return of this additional data to delay the return of the whole cohort headline results so are requesting this additional information is returned to us by **17:00 on 03 September 2018**. Figures are derived in the same way as those held on the DfE School Performance Tables.

Please share this proforma with colleagues such as your Administration Officers who will be dealing with this data as it arrives. To ensure that the information is disseminated efficiently during times of annual leave, I will be sending a copy of this letter and proformas to your Examinations Officer.

As the term progresses in the autumn, there may be changes to your examination percentages. We would be grateful to hear about these changes so that we can update your data.

In order that a whole LA picture is gained we ask that all schools, including academies and sixth form colleges, provide us with information and this will be shared with all schools.

Last year's collection went extremely smoothly and as requested by Headteachers we will send out the first rush results to the Chair of WASSH for onward distribution for both post 16 and GCSE results on 27 August, even though there may be gaps.

Thank you for your assistance in this.
